





The T.E.A.C.H. Organization consists of two programs: the T.E.A.C.H. Accrediting Association and the T.E.A.C.H. Institute.

The T.E.A.C.H. Institute is a federation of accredited home schools that have been accredited by the TEACH Accrediting Association. The T.E.A.C.H. Institute is an independent private school dedicated to assist families who have a conviction from God to train their children at home. Our service sends out student records, and transcripts to interested colleges, universities, the military and employers. We also award high school diplomas to students who have met the criteria for graduation in their state. We provide encouragement and accountability for parents, who receive motivation, and guidance from trained home school consultants. It also provides fellowship with families that have convictions to maintain high character and academic standards for their children.

Accountability is designed to motivate parents to make progress in reaching their academic and character goals for their children. Knowing that a consultant will be verifying the student's academic work provides motivation for them to put forth their best effort. It also gives them confidence that they are receiving and excellent education.

T.E.A.C.H. believes that God has given parents the authority to decide how their children are to be educated and the responsibility to see that this education is according to God's unique design for each child. TEACH consultants serve parents so they can effectively fulfill that responsibility.

Accreditation

SERVICES:

1. Accreditation Status:

All member families may apply to receive accreditation. Accredited families receive all membership services, plus the following...

2. Verification and Encouragement:

Children's progress is verified using the TEACH Academic and Character Progress forms. TEACH consultants review these forms, give recommendations, encouragement and motivation. Consultants are hired by each family independently.

3. Academic Records: As in any private school, each TEACH student has an academic file that verifies the student's academic progress. These records are reliable, trasferrable and accepted as valid by public and private institutions within the educational establishment.

4. Liaison: TEACH also interacts with your district superintendent assuring them that quality education is taking place, so you can spend your time training your children with out distraction.

5. Training: The TEACH Orientation is designed to train parents to succeed in educating their children for God and to encourage fathers to fulfill their important role and responsibility in overseeing the training of their children.

6. High School Student Fee: (\$50 student) Includes:

A. Transcripts: Official high school transcripts are sent out from the TEACH office and are accepted as valid, without question, from colleges, scholarship organizations and the military



ACCREDITING ASSOCIATION

T.E.A.C.H. Accrediting Association

Since 1987 the T.E.A.C.H. Accrediting Association (TAA) has issued over 3,500 certificates of accreditation to home eduating families.

Accreditation means that the homeschool is accountable to someone outside their family, who will stand alongside them and verify that they are maintaining their academic standards and are progressing towards their academic and character goals.

Accreditation is a voluntary, non-governmental process that gives public recognition to home schools that meet published standards of academic quality. It reflects the sturdy American trait of cooperative rather than coercive action in seeking to improve educational services.

The purpose of accreditation is to assure the public, parents, students, and the educational community that the homeschool does have dedication to high standards and the preconditions necessary for offering a quality educational program. This accountability weaves consistency and commitment to quality into the individual school, without succumbing to bureaucratic centralization. The TEACH criteria for accreditation allows for unique differences within educational programs.

Accreditation does not assume that something woefully defective exists, nor does it affirm that the school is perfect in all aspects, but it does certify that the home school has the resources, leadership, and vitality needed for ongoing improvement. We believe that having home schools undertake periodic evaluations is a stimulus for improvement.

□ Credibility: Accreditation gives credibility to your home education program, by having a certified teacher, who has been trained in home tutoring methods, assist you to articulate and attain the God-given goals you have for your children. The academic records that are kept for your children are deemed reliable and our transcripts are accepted by colleges, scholarship organizations, and the military for the verification of high school credits. A TEACH accredited diploma is well-received by all of the secular and religious institutions and opens doors of opportunity.

❑ Verification: Accreditation verifies to the educational community, neighbors, and your extended family, that you are doing what you say you are you are doing. Having someone stand alongside you and assure others that quality education is taking place in your home removes the suspicion of what is going on behind closed doors. □ Confidence: When you are accredited with TEACH, you can be confident that you are giving your children a quality education, no matter what method of education you use. TEACH has very good relationships with district superintendents around the state and the nation. TEACH is also affiliated with the College Board and has a high school code to reference when taking the ACT and SAT college entrance exams.

Guidelines

The following specific guidelines have been designed for those seeking accreditation by the T.E.A.C.H. Accrediting Association (TAA).

A. Parents must request an application for enrollment from the T.E.A.C.H. Institute and follow the procedures required to become a member.

B. Parents shall complete and send in the TEACH Accreditation application form.

C. After an interview, parents choose a consultant and have an initial evaluation with their consultant to determine their curriculum and goals for the year.

D. When accreditation has been approved, parents will receive a Certificate of Accreditation which they may submit to the local superintendent of schools.

E. To remain in good standing with TAA, parents will have periodic self-evaluations with their consultant to determine the home school's strengths and limitations, and then agree on recommendations for improvement.

F. Families who live outside of the Minnesota area and desire accreditation, may conduct their meetings online, via the internet.
